

PENNSYLVANIA INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AUTHORITY

January 15, 2015 UPDATE

Program Began: March, 1988

Type of Organization: An independent agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Enabling Legislation: Act 16 of 1988, The Pennsylvania Infrastructure Authority Act.

Purpose: To give low-interest loans (1-5 percent interest) and some grants to owners and operators of sewer, water and stormwater systems for infrastructure improvements.

Governing Body: A 13-member board of directors with William R. Sasso as chairman designee.

Projects Approved: * 2,771 (1,007 water; 1,533 wastewater; 117 NPS; 15 brownfield; 3 Acid Mine Drainage; 115 storm water)

Funding Approved: \$7.65 billion (\$7,646,853,517)

Permanent jobs created: ** 76,172

Construction jobs created: *** 267,750
