

PENNSYLVANIA INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AUTHORITY

April 22, 2020 UPDATE

Program Began: March, 1988

Type of Organization: An independent agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Enabling Legislation: Act 16 of 1988, The Pennsylvania Infrastructure Authority Act.

Purpose: To give low-interest loans (1-5 percent interest) and some grants to owners and operators of sewer, water and stormwater systems for infrastructure improvements.

Governing Body: A 13-member board of directors with Eric Menzer as chairman designee.

Projects Approved: * 3,083 (1,070 water; 1,684 wastewater; 173 NPS; 17 brownfield; 3 Acid Mine Drainage; 136 storm water)

Funding Approved: \$9.2 billion (\$9,208,464,318)

Permanent jobs created: ** 78,249

Construction jobs created: *** 322,296
