<b>Description</b>	Construction of a 5,000,000 –gallon per day Acid Mine Drainage Treatment Facility along with an 11,000 linear feet of outfall sewer which will allow the dewatering and treatment of the abandoned Shanopin Mine pool in Dunkard Township Greene County.
<b>Project Benefits</b>	<p><i>Public Health/Safety:</i> Project will eliminate the potential for contamination of public water supplies along the Monongahela River</p> <p><i>Environmental Impact:</i> Eliminate the potential impact on recreation, boating and fishing</p> <p><i>Economic Development:</i> This project will have a direct, positive employment effect on two companies Dana Mining of Pennsylvania (DANA) and AMD Reclamation Inc. (AMDRI). Dana Mining will retain 30 jobs and create an additional 50 direct mining jobs. They will be investing \$6million in construction renovations and equipment costs. AMDRI will be creating 20-30 construction jobs and the treatment plant will require at least one fulltime plant operator plus associated spin off jobs (lime truck drivers, chemical and petroleum suppliers, etc.)</p> <p><i>Compliance:</i> Project will allow for compliance with a Department of Environmental Protection Consent decree with AMD Reclamation Inc and Dana Mining Inc.</p> <p><i>Adequacy/Efficiency/Social Impact:</i> The project will allow for the dewatering and treatment of the abandoned Shanopin Mine Pool by AMD Reclamation Inc, which will prevent the environmental degradation of Dunkard Creek and the Monongahela River along with the preservation of the related Dana Mining operation.</p>
