

**PENNSYLVANIA INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AUTHORITY**

**April 25, 2012 UPDATE**

Program Began: March, 1988

Type of Organization: An independent agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Enabling Legislation: Act 16 of 1988, The Pennsylvania Infrastructure Authority Act.

Purpose: To give low-interest loans (1-5 percent interest) and some grants to owners and operators of sewer, water and stormwater systems for infrastructure improvements.

Governing Body: A 13-member board of directors with Joseph M. Manko as chairman designee.

Projects Approved: \* 2,617 (957 water; 1,444 wastewater; 83 NPS; 15 brownfield; 3 Acid Mine Drainage; 115 storm water)

Funding Approved: \$6.9 billion (\$6,863,961,843)

Permanent jobs created: \*\* 72,178

Construction jobs created: \*\*\* 240,239

- \*\* Obtained by totaling up new jobs created (excludes retained jobs) as reported in the DCED's ranking write-ups, and reflected in the Board book (2,362) **and adding** that to the total from the previous update (69,816)= 72,178.
- \*\*\* Obtained by using total "funding approval" \$6,863,961,843 \* 35 jobs/\$million = 240,239. In doing this calculation, the total approved amount was rounded to \$6.9 billion.
