

PENNSYLVANIA INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AUTHORITY

July 18, 2012 UPDATE

Program Began: March, 1988

Type of Organization: An independent agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Enabling Legislation: Act 16 of 1988, The Pennsylvania Infrastructure Authority Act.

Purpose: To give low-interest loans (1-5 percent interest) and some grants to owners and operators of sewer, water and stormwater systems for infrastructure improvements.

Governing Body: A 13-member board of directors with Joseph M. Manko as chairman designee.

Projects Approved: * 2,635 (963 water; 1,452 wastewater; 87 NPS; 15 brownfield; 3 Acid Mine Drainage; 115 storm water)

Funding Approved: \$7.0 billion (\$6,951,395,170)

Permanent jobs created: ** 72,299

Construction jobs created: *** 245,000

- *** Obtained by using total "funding approval" \$6,951,395,170 * 35 jobs/\$million = 245,000. In doing this calculation, the total approved amount was rounded to \$7.0 billion.
